Dear Members of the FCPF Participants Committee and Observers,

The Facility Management Team proposes a slight change of dates for the PC6 meeting of June 2010, namely to hold the meeting the week of June 28 instead of June 21. This would provide one extra week to the countries submitting Readiness Preparation Proposals for review at the PC6 meeting.

Guyana, the host country, agrees to this proposed date change. Please let us know if you have any objections.

The week of the PC5 meeting in Gabon are confirmed: March 22-26, 2010.

I also take the opportunity to advise you that Norway has offered to host the PC9 meeting of June 2011.

As things stand, the schedule for the next FCPF meetings would thus be as follows:

PC9: June 2011 (Norway) TO BE CONFIRMED
