General Comments

- **PC Review: June 2012**
 - **PC Members appreciate this kind of cooperation between FCPF and FIP**
- **Burkina Faso's R-PP is a good presentation of the REDD+ process in this country and is a good example for other non-rainforest countries**



Strenghts

- **R-PP clearly underlines the process of information sharing, participation and consultation with key stakeholders**
- **R-PP clearly develops a cross-sectoral approach**
- **The 4 REDD+ strategy options proposed are in line with the direct and indirect drivers of deforestation**
- **The R-PP presents a good methodology for the development of a reference level**



Areas for Further Improvements

- The analysis of the deforestation drivers :
 - the roles played by agriculture, overgrazing and energy wood should be precised
 - land grabbing /agrobusiness should be better analyzed
- The participation of local populations in the Monitoring system is not mentioned
- Program Monitoring and Evaluation Framework : some indicators should be precised
- MRV and SESA need additional budget



Selected Recommendations

“largely met”

- **Insufficient information on the status of land tenure and natural resource ownership**
- **Precisions on the availability and the quality of the data that will be used to assess the reference level**



“Partially met”

- **No information on government’s commitment**
- **Past failures in implementing policies for addressing land tenure are not presented**
- **WB’ safeguards are not mentioned**
- **The impact of the strategy on the forestry sector, on governance and on the drivers of deforestation is not assessed**
