REDD Readiness Progress Fact Sheet COUNTRY: CENTRAL AFRICA REPUBLIC March, 2012

1. R-PP Preparation and FCPF Readiness grant

- The R-PP was approved by the FCPF Participant Committee meeting in Berlin on October 2011. The resolution listed a series of recommendations to be addressed and reflected in the revised R-PP prior entering a grant agreement with the Delivery Partner
- The Government of CAR has made a formal request to work with the UNDP as a Delivery partner for the Readiness Preparation activities.
- Transfer Agreement between the Bank and the UNDP is under finalization.
- A workshop was organized by the National REDD Coordination with the representatives of the CSOs (about 40 attendees) on March 9th in Bangui to present the outcomes of the Berlin meeting and the "feuille de route" to finalize the R-PP and re-submit to FMT for completeness check. However, the feuille de route did not indicate any date for the submission of the revised R-PP.
- Discussions with partners (particularly European Commission) show some interest to co-finance the R-PP implementation: the National REDD Coordination needs to be more active in securing additional funds.

2. National REDD Readiness Management Arrangements

- One Presidential decree setting the institutional REDD Arrangement (National REDD Committee and National Coordination REDD) was issued on November 8th, 2011; it is complemented by an Arrêté, dated February 6th, 2012 designating the members of the National Coordination REDD.
- The National REDD Coordination team has been set up based on the Arrêté: it is a multi-sectoral team and the different members seem knowledgeable of the REDD process. (Most of them were involved in the preparation of the R-PP).

3. Stakeholder Consultations and Communication

- CSOs members represent the majority of the membership of the National REDD Committee. However, no National REDD Committee meeting has been held yet.
- A workshop was organized on March 9th in Bangui with the representatives of the CSOs. The CSOs have expressed a strong interest in participating and contributing to the Readiness Preparation process. The modalities of consultation need however to be improved (cf invitation, dissemination of the documentation) and a special attention should be focused on this during the implementation of the R-PP (Comp. 1b)

4. REDD Strategy Preparation

- The FCPF Participant Committee recommended that Terms of reference for a comprehensive study on drivers and agents of deforestation and forest degradation be prepared prior CAR can enter into a Readiness Preparation Grant Agreement with the Delivery Partner.

5. Implementation Framework

- The issue Funds Management was largely debated during the R-PP presentation to the FCPF Participant Committee: as a result, the resolution includes a provision that a clear indication should be added in the R-PP that an in-depth participatory analysis of options to manage REDD funds in CAR be conducted during the R-PP implementation.

6. SESA

- Limited progress has been made on that front.

7. Development of a Reference Scenario

No activity to report at this stage. Activities to be launched once the second tranche of FCPF financing is available.

- Two training sessions on Satellite images (each of about 10 days) have been organized over the past few months (once with GAF project and another under the partnership AFD-Astrium)
