The additional on-ground studies and activities for REDD+ Readiness are covered with this grant. The REDD+ readiness work lay ground for Liberia to receive support to its forest sector from Norway, under the Letter of Intent signed in September 2014 (total commitment of US\$150 million equivalent at the time of the signing).

In addition, several of the CSOs are engaged in various initiatives which are complementary to REDD+ and thereby are continually offering useful lessons and insights to guide and strengthen the REDD+ readiness process.
