The subsistence of most of its inhabitants is based on self-consumption agriculture: corn, beans, bananas, plantain, guava, coffee, pejibaye, chayotes, squash and some tubers, such as cassava, tiquizque, yams and taro.</p> <p>2. Cabécar Nairi Awari indigenous territory with extension of 5,038 km and 509 inhabitants, the communities are matrilineal.</p>
