Session 2a. Update on Carbon Fund Progress Since CF28

Background: The FMT will present progress made under the Carbon Fund since CF28, including updates on ER payments, social inclusion, MRV, registry, communications, and knowledge management.

Background documentation: A presentation will be available on the CF29 page.

Expected CFP Action: CFPs are invited to take note of the presentation and request clarification if needed.

Session 2b. Portfolio management update

Background: The FMT will present an overview of the programs in the FCPF Carbon Fund portfolio and the financial status and ERPA commitments, including an update on the status of the signed ERPAs.

Session 2c. Monetization of Excess ERs

Background: The FMT will provide CFPs with an update on efforts to monetize Excess ERs as well as an update on ongoing efforts at the technical level to support countries to transfer the Excess ERs to third-party buyers.

Session 2d. ERPA Flexibility

Background: In light of discussions during CF28 and post-CF28 consultations, the FMT will present an updated proposal to change the portfolio management strategy by considering country requests for additional ERPA flexibility to pursue monetization of credits in the carbon market.

Expected CFP Action: CFPs are invited to review the FMT Note and presentation and requested to approve a change in the portfolio management strategy by considering country requests for additional ERPA flexibility as outlined in the FMT note.

Session 2e. Impactful BSP

Session 2f. FCPF Standard

Session 3. Deep Dive Learning Session
