The objective of the grant is to to support Vietnam to become ready for future REDD+ implementation by preparing the key elements, systems and policies needed in a socially and environmentally sound manner.

The FCPF provides grant funding to contribute to the preparation for REDD+ Readiness of Vietnam, including the development of supporting policies and systems, support for adopting national REDD+ strategies, development of reference emission levels (RELs); the designing of a measurement, reporting, and verification (MRV) systems; and setting up REDD+ national management arrangements, including improvements to existing environmental and social safeguards. FCPF is also supporting work on stakeholder consultations and engagement at different levels, including consultation work with forest dependent village communities, protected area Management Boards, State Forest Companies, District and Provincial officials and non government organizations. The Grant implementation is on track of achieving the grant objectives and is assessed to be Satisfactory.

Overall progress from 07/01/2015 to 06/30/2016 with regard to Implementation of Grant Financed Activities: Comment:

Significant progress in REDD Readiness preparation has been achieved including capacity building activities at various level; contribution to the review of National REDD Action Plan (NRAP); development of selective Provincial REDD Action Plan (PRAPs) as well as coordinating other bilateral supports to provide inputs into the Emission Reduction Program Document (ERPD) for the North Central region of Vietnam, the advanced version of which has become available and the Program will be presented to the donors Participants' Committee planned to be in December 2016. Progress has also been achieved under the large package including the SESA work, Socio-Economic Study for the ER Program Area, completion of the R-Package Assessment, Mid Term Review Report and consultation work. The two-stage approached SESA had been adopted with the first stage SESA being completed for the ER-Program area. Since most of the key tasks had satisfactorily been completed, the implementation of the grant is upgraded to Satisfactory from the status of MS in the last reporting period.

3. Describe progress in addressing key capacity issues (implementation, technical, financial management, procurement) related to this Grant.

Changes in key staffing has significantly improved implementation (eg. the appointment of the full time position of the PMU Deputy Director and Vietnam REDD Office). Fiduciary trainings including on FM and procurement were provided to PMU staff and implementation support has been provided by the Bank's task team.

4. Describe progress in addressing social and environmental issues (including safeguards) related to the Grant. Is the SESA conducted in accordance with the Common Approach?

SESA consultant position in the PMU was filled and the consultant was fully on board to supervise the implementation of the SESA package which is in accordance with the Common Approach.

5. Is the ESMF prepared in accordance with the Common Approach?

With the initiative of key donors in Vietnam such as WB, ADB, DFAT, USAID and partners, streamlining procedures and instruments for social and environment safeguards are being discussed, including an ESMF template that was recently developed for Vietnam. It was agreed that the environmental and social instruments and approaches used in the FCPF program will made consistent with the approach used for other donor/WB projects in Vietnam, which is in accordance with the Common Approach.

The SESA/ESMF work focussed on both national and provincial REDD strategies, appropriate consultations, analytical work including the review of the newer Land and Environmental laws as they pertain to the ER programs. There is a wealth of very good background technical material from numerous partners (e.g., USAID, SNV, Winrock, JICA, SRD, GIZ etc.) that can provide solid evidence and inputs for these efforts. Plans for further refinement around the unique aspects of drivers of forest degradation and deforestation at the provincial level will be addressed.

6. Describe progress in stakeholder consultation, participation, disclosure of information, and the FGRM related to this Grant.

A comprehensive communications and stakeholder consultation plan for potential stakeholders was developed in April 2014, based on which numerous communication activities were organized.

The Project has improved communication on the FCPF REDD+ at provincial and lower levels, including awareness raising; # The project has supported awareness raising and training of trainers for FPIC in three FCPF provinces.

Work has been undertaken with FCPF pilot village communities and provinces on developing procedures for improved implementation of Payment for Forest Environmental Services (PFES) and forest land allocation and review of the impact of the new Land Law (ongoing from August 2014);

Intensive consultation were carried out during the development of the PRAPs, ERPD, land tenure study, SESA/ESMP development and Benefit Sharing Mechanism, among others.
