- 1. Working Group on Forest and Climate Change established through the Minister of Forestry Decree No. 13/2009)
- 2. REDD Guidelines (Regulation on REDD Demonstration Activity/PERMENHUT No. 68/2008 and Regulation on REDD implementation/PERMENHUT No. 30/2009)
- 3. REDD Commission (inter-sectoral), mandated by PERMENHUT No. 30/2009 (pending)
- 4. Relevant progress : establishment of *Indonesia Climate Change Trust Fund,* where REDD is in one of the windows.





WHERE ARE WE NOW ? (national level) : technical/methodological and field activities

- Continuing the work programme of FRIS/INCAS : data collection and processing (MoFor Planning Agency LAPAN),
- Research activities to support FRIS/INCAS (FORDA etc),
- Stakeholder communication : on-going
- Demonstration Activities : Id Australia/KFCP, Id Germany, Id –Korea, Id – ITTO, Id-TNC.
