General comments

- Congratulations on a very comprehensive piece of work
- all standards met / largely met
- strong analytical thinking and coordinating efforts
- Responds well to most earlier reviewer and stakeholder concerns

Key strengths:

- REDD+ well embedded in national climate change policy
- Strong representation of key-stakeholders in REDD+ Working Group
- broad & constructive information-sharing with stakeholders
- national SESA workshop in November
- well-thought allignment of drivers and strategy options
- ambitious monitoring system

Areas for further improvement

...recommended attention during grant preparation & implementation

Consolidate institutional set-up:

- operational arrangements of the REDD+ Working Group and Consultative Groups still to be defined
- intersectorial coordination
- Clarify governance and strategy options for indigenous and afrocolombian collective territories:
 - further clarify rights and responsibilities
 - input to technical studies on drivers and strategy options

Areas for further improvement

Reference Level and Monitoring System:

- Transparency: public access to methodology and data
- workplan and timeline for transition to national reference level
- options for integrating local stakeholders into monitoring (incl. budget)

Non-carbon monitoring:

- suggested indicators & SESA results
- sufficient budget for data-gathering in remote areas?
- may consider governance indicators
