General Comments

- Very good improvement since last review, most of the comments made are taken into account.
- It has strengthened the focus and scope of participation of stakeholders
- Some technical issues have been clarified regarding the construction of baseline and monitoring system
- Interagency coordination seems to strengthen as the process advance, very important that MINEM was included in the coordination

Some issues to improve (1)

- The specific roles and responsibilities of stakeholders in the preparation of REDD+ still need to be further detailed
- How to ensure that participation is finally not limited to technical experts, but people in the field will also participate with commitment
- How Peru will meet its international obligations stemming from the ratification of ILO 169 (which is also a necessary part of SESA) while the “Ley de Consulta Previa” is being assessed.

Some issues to improve (2)

- More clarity about the link between the R-PP and the processes to draft an investment strategy for funding through the Forest Investment Program (FIP). A draft REDD+ investment strategy is expected in June – will the necessary analytical work be ready by then?
