Progress with the due diligence activities work in Guyana

"Due Diligence" Activities

- Ensure that preparation phase follows operational policies including fiduciary, social, and environmental safeguards
- Identify key issues relevant to REDD in Guyana (e.g., land tenure) and evaluate if there is a process in place to address such issues during preparation phase.
- Conduct a preliminary analysis and engagement with stakeholders: workshops, field observations, desk reviews.
- Prepare and consult draft SESA TOR.
- Agree on institutional arrangements and assess fiduciary capacity.
- Bank team: social, land, legal, safeguards, fiduciary, forest, environment, indigenous people, communication.

Progress to Date

- WB grant preparation activities: (i) two missions in July and October 2009; (ii) field trip with a multi-stakeholder team including Govt, Amerindian NGOs, Toshaos, international NGOs and donors; (iii) meetings with 16 Amerindian communities; (iv) meetings with government, private sector, political opposition, diaspora, advocacy groups.
- **SESA:** TORs drafted and to be disclosed for comments.
- **R-PP as a living document:** revised version posted on line since March 16, 2010.
- Processing of the Formulation Grant: to be co-implemented by Forestry Commission (technical studies) and National Toshaos Council (community information and awareness), currently being reviewed by Govt.



Key Elements Identified During DD Process

- Consultation Plan: Adequate and timely consultations during the REDD preparation phase – remoteness, language, cost.
- **FPIC**: includes proposal for 'opt-in/opt-out' approach.
- Resettlement Policy Framework (Process Framework):
 Alternative sustainable activities to address possible restriction of access to natural resources.
- Land and resource use rights: addressing land issues as an element of REDD (e.g. titling of Amerindian lands, case in court for eleven years)
- Adequacy of the legal framework: would be analyzed as part of the SESA during the Preparation Phase



- Carbon rights and benefit sharing: to be addressed during preparation phase
- Institutional Arrangement: R-PP to address engagement of relevant ministries.
- Inclusiveness of REDD framework: participation of key stakeholders.
- Manage expectations: stay within FCPF mandate/scope of REDD
