REDD+ in Costa Rica

- Costa Rica has high expectations to generate options for climate change mitigation & adaptation
- Forest sector is key in C-neutrality national goal (Domestic C market established) and fully embedded in the national Climate Change Strategy
- REDD+ seeks to strengthen program of payments for environmental services (PES) and strengthen cross- institutional coordination and political guidance
- REDD+ intends to support local economies, maximize co-benefits and store C in long-lasting wood products
- Costa Rica to implement REDD+ in a context of financial sustainability and within a landscape restoration strategy towards a *green and inclusive development and poverty eradication*



- **Organization and consultation.** Early dialogue established with Ombudsman's Office to serve as observer for consultation in indigenous territories.
- Grievance Redress Mechanism. Designed completed, pilot to start in August '14.
- Land use change. Assessment for 1990-2013 to derive sound reference level.
- **Strategic options.** Analysis of risks to draft policy options to support implementation plans & budgets.

• Implementation framework. New PES modalities to be developed for indigenous territories and small land-holders.





•Implementation framework. Assessment of VCS JNR for additional crediting & allow nested projects.


• Monitoring. National Forest Inventory at 80%, Rapid-Eye national map completed.

• Monitoring. Work plan with FAO to integrate AFOLU accounting (REDD+ and NAMAs in national GHG inventory).

•**REDD+ financing plan**. To be updated in Aug '14, funding approved.

• Monitoring & Evaluation. Updated with FCPF in Mar '14.






Road to R-Package






Integrated approach for Sustainable REDD+
