

## **FGRM Session**

### **Guidance for group work**

#### **Purpose of the exercise**

Based on a contentious issue in the field of REDD+ social inclusion, participants will form teams of two countries to do an analysis and develop a FGRM good practice toolbox. The FGRM should be effective, lead to justice and be feasible.

#### **Procedure for exercise**

- For the breakout groups, participants will be divided into teams of two countries each; every group will be provided with a matrix to work with.
- Minister Fernando from Shangriland has asked for support to design a FGRM for two relevant issues, one of which is in the first column.
- According to the guidance that is provided in the matrix, each group will design what it considers would be an effective FGRM that leads to justice and is feasible.
- Teams will have 1 hour to work.
- 1 or 2 representatives from each team will present the results of the matrix (10 minutes maximum per team please).
- Upon completion of the three presentations, an evaluation panel consisting of 3 people will provide a reasoned rating to each of the presentations.
- The session expert will provide his closing remarks.
