




FCPF Capacity Building Programs (Without Alignment)

Benefits of Alignment

Strategic impact:

- Concrete collaboration between FIP and FCPF for the benefit of Indigenous Peoples and local communities
- Expansion of the global knowledge exchange forum envisaged by the FIP to include FCPF beneficiaries
- Potential to grow and attract co-financing

Efficiency:

- Avoidance of duplication of activities and reinforcement of complementarity
- No addition of administrative layers but sharing and streamlining of new features, so overall better use of available donor resources:
 - Creation of a single Global Steering Committee (instead of two) Membership to be confirmed to represent beneficiaries of both programs
 - Optimization of the Global Executing Agency (to serve the FCPF as well as the FIP)
 - Optimization of the coordinating unit within the World Bank (to serve the FCPF as well as the FIP)
- These gains will be achieved without co-mingling the funds from the FCPF and FIP or undermining the governance structures of either program
