Why is the initiation needed?



- ☐IPs constitute 38% of the total population of the country
- ☐ Multiple relationship with the nature including forest
- ☐ Nepal's move towards REDD+ Readiness
- Lessons, experiences and knowledge embedded with our culture
- ☐ Lack of reciprocal communication
- □Low level of awareness about REDD+ processes that questions the successful implementation of REDD+ readiness
- ☐ High demand of community level awareness
